We are here at Chester House as the Communist Party of Kenya, The United Green Movement Party, the National Students Caucus and Kenya Tuitakayo Movement to say no to this madness. It is a cup that we shall not drink from. We are here to start a march to the Fourth Liberation of Kenya.

We are here at Chester House, as The Communist Party of Kenya, The United Green Movement Party, The National Students Caucus and Kenya Tuitakayo Movement, to pray that the spirit of the fathers of the second liberation hear us. Today we will be marching to the Statue of Dedan Kimathi to pay homage and to immortalize his Kenyan spirit of struggle. To say prayers to demand our country back. We will be praying that the spirit of the Kenya's liberation struggle resurrects in us. May the fathers of the second liberation and the founders of the Kenya nation hear us. We will be the Dedan Kimathis statue to say prayers for an inclusive government, where the rule of law, not the rule of men, of President Kenyatta and the former Prime Minister Raila Odinga, reign supreme. We know it may cost us life, but we are here to take risks. We are here to dare. We will push and move the struggle at all costs. We say to them; start trembling! If you have stolen, tremble! If you have looted, tremble! If you have grabbed, tremble! If you have engaged in impunity, tremble! Because we will be marching towards you, it might not be this year, next year, five years, but we will come for you! Democratic power is the business of a conscious people. The Kenyan people have become conscious, and they know our country has been taken far too long in the wrong direction.

We have witnessed President Uhuru Kenyatta plunder the resources of the country under the Standard Gauge Railway, the National Youth Service Scandal, the Arror- Kimwarer Scandal, the COVID-19 Billionaire Scandal, just to mention a few. We know of the Kazi Kwa Vijana Scandal under the former Prime minister Raila Odinga. We also know of the National Youth Service Scandal under President Uhuru Kenyatta with the acquiescence of former Prime Minister Odinga, with his 'power foam' cleaning that made the scandal as white as snow. We will be marching across the streets of Nairobi to proclaim the birth and the launch of the fourth and final liberation movement. We appeal to all Kenyans who wish for an inclusive government, of a country under the rule of law, of a country with independent institutions, of a country with a free and a fair media, of a country with a robust civil society, of a country where the decisions of the judiciary are not **REVISITED**, of a country where the executive does not have its knees on the neck of Parliament, of a country where the executive obeys and respects court orders to join the movement.

We are appealing to all Kenyans in their various formations, Political Parties, Social Movements, Community Based Organizations, Students Unions, Trade Unions, Farmers Organizations, whomsoever you are, whomsoever you could be, to please join the Communist Party of Kenya, The United Green Movement Party, The National Students Caucus and Kenya Tuitakayo Movement as we March across this country. After this launch of the Fourth Liberation Movement, hoping that it is the final and last liberation movement, we hope when it is done, we will have arrived at the country envisaged by the founding fathers of this nation, where plenty is found within our borders, and all Kenyans live in peace, pursuing life, liberty and happiness. May the spirit of the fathers of the Second liberation and the spirit of the founding Fathers of the Nation hear us!
