

WE WILL NOT RELENT IN OUR PUSH FOR THE RULE OF LAW, THE DEFENCE, THE UPHOLDING AND RESPECT FOR THE RIGHTS OF ALL KENYANS

Fellow Countrymen, on the 28th of October, 2021 we gathered here as the United Progressive Front of the United Green Movement, the Communist Party of Kenya and the UKweli Party. We spoke on the issues of the Rule of Law. We emphasized that the Rule of Law is part of the national values and principles of governance espoused in Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 that should bind all state organs, state officers, public officers whenever they make or implement public policy decisions.

As a United Progressive Front we took issue with the President not appointing 4 Judges of the Court of Appeal and 2 Judges of the High Court, in total disregard of court orders. We highlighted the issue of the state not compensating the Nyayo era political detainees besides numerous court orders that the payments be effected. We also highlighted the issue of Dr. Miguna Miguna, who has not been allowed into the country following his forceful eviction by the state close to four years ago, despite numerous court orders that the state facilitates his entry.

It is the belief on the rule of law that makes nations civilized, absent that, a nation is simply inviting anarchy upon itself. The Constitution of Kenya at Article 159 bestows judicial authority. This judicial authority is derived from the people, and vests in, and shall be exercised by, the courts and tribunals established by the Constitution. It need not be gainsaid that in Kenya, it is the people who are sovereign and any State Officer, Public Officer whosoever they may be, only exercises delegated authority as an agent of the people, who are principal.

As a United Progressive Front, we are here to make our claim on the demands by the Constitution. The Constitution of Kenya at Article 3 (1) states that 'every person has an obligation to respect, uphold and defend this Constitution'. We are here to assure Kenyans that we will not relent in our defense, for the upholding, the respect for the rights of all Kenyans; and defending the independence and integrity of the judiciary.

Kenyans are well aware that the other arms of Government in Kenya, the Legislature and the Executive are since extractive, not representing the will of the people. The only arm that is keeping us afloat as a country is the Judiciary. As United Progressive Front, we shall fight to ensure that all the orders that come from the Judiciary are respected and enforced.

We were expecting to receive Dr. Miguna Miguna in the Country this morning. Our advocates had gone to court a few days ago, to ensure that any 'red alerts' to airlines that would stop Dr. Miguna Miguna from flying into the Country are removed. The Attorney General misinformed the courts that there were no such 'red alerts', in effect, the courts would not give orders in vain. As a country, we are all now aware that the Attorney General misinformed and misdirected the

Courts of Law. That level of impunity from the principal legal advisor to the government of Kenya, should worry every Kenyan.


